The ocean does not contain much plant life, because concentrations of critical nutrients are lower than they are on land Phosphorus and nitrogen, for example, are present at only 1/ 10,000 of their concentration in fertile soil As a consequence, the ocean supports only a small fraction of what can be grown on reasonably productive land
