A light touch is perceived through receptors on the surface layer of the skin, while firmer pressure is perceived by receptors in the subcutaneous and deep layers of the skin Pressure sensibility is a protective sensation that prevents exposure to deep pressure or repetitive light pressure that can result in injury to the skin Light touch
