Sea lions and fur seals, the Otariidae, are adapted to avoid heat loss while foraging in cold water The body surface is insulated with a thick layer of fat and, in the fur seals, by dense pelage sea lions breed on flat rocky shelves bordered inland by 30-40 m high sandstone cliffs that form a steep, nearly perpendicular wall, six metres
