The client identified a need to reduce his/her focus on others' functioning and to replace this with a focus on his/her own functioning alcoholic traits, and the focus of treatment was turned toward this defensiveness The client was taught the ACOA rules for living (ie, "don't talk, don't trust, don't feel")
